FUNDING RESOURCES

The CoMotion Innovation Investments group provides internal gap funding and helps UW projects and startups identify and apply for commercialization funds. A funding gap exists when basic research funding is no longer appropriate and a project needs funds for product development. Many federal agencies and non-profit foundations make funds available to help technologies bridge this gap. These translational or commercialization awards provide innovators with non-dilutive funding, and allow them to maintain working ties between their spinoff and the UW research group.


